Sexual Health Services in Local Pharmacies

Emergency Hormonal Contraception (morning after pill) The emergency contraceptive pill should be taken within 3 days (72 hours) of unprotected sex (but needs to be taken as soon as possible to be effective and the earlier it is taken, the more likely it is to work). Sometimes emergency contraception can be given up to 5 days (120 hours) after unprotected sex, so always ask if needed. Ec

Emergency contraception DOES NOT protect against sexually transmitted infections.

All the pharmacies (chemist shops) listed here can provide condoms, pregnancy tests and the emergency contraceptive pill free to females under 21 years of age. They also offer free chlamydia screening and treatment to anyone under 25 years of age. Some also offer the oral contraceptive pill.
